Can the software be installed on more than one computer at my school? Which software do we need to install on desktop PCs?

The software that you would need to load on your desktop PC is the VariQuest Design Center Software. A copy of this software was included in your school's initial investment in VariQuest Visual Learning Tools. If you need additional copies of the software, you can request that a VariQuest version 2.0 Software Kit be shipped out to your school by completing the form available at: <http://www.variquest.com/software-update>. Your investment in VariQuest Visual Learning Tools includes a site license, so you may install this software on as many computers in your school as you like.

Where can I find the Jeopardy board Poster Maker template?

The Jeopardy board was created by customizing the Blank Layout 39: LAY039 Poster Maker template.

Can I cut any magnetic material on the Cutout Maker or do I have to use VariQuest magnetic material?

We recommend using VariQuest magnetic material in order to ensure a quality cut.

Will the language arts manipulatives shown in the proofreading example be available in Spanish?

The Spanish characters that are available for the Cutout Maker using the Lloyd VQ font include: Á, É, Í, Ó, Ú, Ñ, Ü, á, é, í, ó, ú, ñ, ü, ¡, and ¿.

How do I adjust the paper when using the Cutout Maker to determine that the shapes cut out in the appropriate color?

The shapes that you add to any job are arranged on the paper to conserve the most space. We recommend that you cut all shapes from a job on the same color paper. If you'd like to change colors, you should start a new cut job.

What can I do if the paper rips when I am cutting out shapes on the Cutout Maker, but the paper is fine when I am cutting out letters?

One possible cause for paper to rip is if the shapes are cut out at a size that is smaller than the recommended minimum cut size for that shape. Try increasing the size of the shape that you are trying to cut to see if that resolves the problem.
