Q: I have an older version of Inspiration. Am I able to use that with the VariQuest Poster Maker?

A: You need Inspiration version 9.0a to print posters on the VariQuest Poster Maker. This was released in April, 2010. If you already have Inspiration 9.0, you can update to 9.0a for free at www.inspiration.com/Help-Center/Inspiration#updater. To upgrade from an earlier version, visit <http://store.inspiration.com/> or contact us at customerservice@inspiration.com.

Q: You showed a lot of graphic organizer and map templates. Can my students and I create our own graphic organizers, concept maps, mind maps and webs to print to the Poster Maker?

A: Absolutely. When printing to the Poster Maker, all of the capabilities of Inspiration are intact, including the ability to create your own diagrams, mind maps and outlines from scratch. Additionally, if you have an 8 ½" x 11" copy of a graphic organizer that you would like to enlarge, you may use the built-in scanner on the cover of the Poster Maker to create a poster-size version.

Q: I saw quite a few multi-color templates in the presentation. I thought that the Poster Maker only printed in one color. Please explain.

A: You are correct, the Poster Maker is a thermal printer and the color of the poster created is determined by whatever color paper is loaded in the machine. When printing full color templates from Inspiration, the Poster Maker will automatically adjust the template to print a poster in whatever color paper is loaded.

Q: How do I print from Inspiration software to the Poster Maker?

A: In order to print from Inspiration Software to the Poster Maker you must have the Poster Maker print driver installed on the PC, laptop or Design Center that you are printing from and you must be connected to the Poster Maker. If you have the VariQuest Design Center Software installed on your machine, then you will automatically have the Poster Maker print driver installed as well. From here all you need to do is open the Inspiration file that you would like to print then select "Print to Poster Maker" from the drop down menu under "File" in the upper left hand corner of the software.
