How do I know which collections my school has?

You can see all content that is available to you by changing the Content Preferences settings in the Design Center Software v2.0. The Content Preferences settings can be accessed in the Browse Categories screen. Select the Change button, then check the box next to Show Activated Content Only, and select OK.

Where can I find the content guide that Kathy Schrock mentioned?

Who has access to use the Cutout Maker at your school? Is it open to all staff or only certain people?

Kathy Schrock: Originally we kept the Cutout Maker in a locked room because we did not want staff to use it unattended. We decided to move it to the Library Media Center so that our library media specialist could oversee the routine maintenance and ensure that all staff was using it correctly. Most of our staff attended a training on the Cutout Maker prior to using the machine so they had a basic understanding of how it works.

Brian Singleton: We have given all of our staff access to the Cutout Maker, as well as parent volunteers and student teachers. We have not had any problems with making it available to everyone because the machine is so intuitive and easy to use.
